Approved addition to cluster standards for exterior colors and materials for decks in Timberview Cluster, to include the following:

- Trex, color: Gravel Path (addition)
- Trex, color: Rope Swing (addition)
- Trex, color: Tree House (addition)
- Trex, color: Vintage Lantern (addition)
- Trex, color: Saddle (remove)
- Cabot Stain, color: Bark Mulch (remove)
- Clear, colorless sealant (existing)
- Stained to match house siding (existing)
- Rustoleum Deck Coat, color: Russet (existing)
- Deck Helmut, color: Walnut (existing)
- McCormick, color: Amber White #101 for handrails and spindles only (existing)
- Sherwin Williams solid Stain color code to match approved Trex colors (addition)

with the following stipulations:

Unit owners must bring their deck color into conformance with the approved color palette upon the sale of their property or if it is noted during an annual inspection.

The entire deck must be brought into conformance with the approved exterior color and material at the same time.

As amended, to include the following changes:

Trex, color: Saddle to be removed.

Cabot Stain, color: Bark Mulch to be removed.

Sherwin Williams solid Stain color code to match approved Trex colors to be added.

Approval of any particular plans and specifications or design does not waive the right of the DRB to disapprove such plans and specifications, or any elements or features thereof, if such plans and specifications are subsequently submitted for use in any other instance or by any other person or entity.
